

Answering the call

'Yes, I will help'

It's always difficult when asked to write a brief personal biography as it obviously necessitates self reflection.

I'm a California transplant having moved here from New Jersey because of my husband's career with my three youngest children. In New Jersey I did all of the usual "mom" volunteer things including serving as President of our school's parent organization and doing several terms on the Metuchun Diocesan Board of Education.

The most rewarding volunteer work I did during those years was in a program called "Girl Scouts Beyond Bars." My opening line at any event was always, "I've been to prison."

Our mission was to connect girls and incarcerated mothers through a unique Girl Scout troop that was funded through the U.S. Department of Justice. As a long standing troop leader and prolific cookie seller, when our local chapter asked for volunteers to form a Girl Scout troop within the walls of the Edna Mann State Correctional Facility, my interest was piqued and I became a dedicated and avid volunteer until we left New Jersey.

I became a Guild member in 2004, only a few years after we moved to Los Angeles.

When I was first introduced to Maryvale and its young residents, I was immediately moved by their plight and stories. I saw sadness, but also witnessed hope largely due to the efforts of the incredible staff at Maryvale and the volunteerism and fundraising of the Guild. I knew it was something I wanted to be a part of.

Having raised a large and boisterous family, it was seamless for me to continue reaching out to children in real need. There is nothing more gratifying in this world than helping our most vulnerable citizens. Volunteerism is an honorable and just calling.

I am grateful to my husband Robert for his support and encouragement throughout the years.

I am deeply moved and touched to be this year's recipient of the Countess Doheny Award. This is not an individual award, but a shared award with every Guild member who has ever said, yes I will help.

Through your generous support, we will succeed in this mission and continue touching the hearts of those in need.



Dear Friends of Maryvale and the Los Angeles Orphanage Guild,

Welcome to the 2022 Los Angeles Orphanage Guild's Gala celebration "Starry Night!" For over 70 years, it has been Maryvale's privilege to partner with the members of the Guild to support underserved and vulnerable children and families in Southern California. We are most grateful for this relationship and the myriad ways in which the Guild has contributed over the years to the success and well-being of Maryvale and those we serve.

We have journeyed into 2022 with hearts and minds full of hope and excitement about the road ahead. After two difficult and trying years, Maryvale is looking forward to the next chapter and to new beginnings. While we still face challenges, we consider these as opportunities to move forward in new and different ways, re-inventing ourselves along the way.

When Maryvale's leadership made the decision to close our short-term residential therapeutic program (STRTP) in August of 2020, we ended over 160 years of residential services for children dating back to the original orphanage in 1856. Throughout our history, changes like this have not been uncommon; the Daughters of Charity have always been committed to meeting the current and emerging needs of the community. As Los Angeles County's longest-operating children's charity dedicated to serving children, youth and families, we embarked in 2021 on developing a new strategic plan in an effort to explore ways to make a greater impact in the communities we serve. Our year-long strategic planning process has helped us to envision ways to serve more vulnerable individuals with a wider range of services.

We are poised to move forward and put into practice our vision of Maryvale's future as an organization that will continue to address the needs of the underserved for the next 166 years.

While we have entered into a new era for Maryvale, we remain dedicated to the transformative work we do every day, and are proud of the way we make a difference in the greater community. We will continue to offer and expand access to high-quality early education programs and services at our two campuses in Rosemead and Duarte and provide community-based mental health outpatient and wraparound services for children and families in need. We are pleased to announce the addition of child and adolescent substance abuse and dual-diagnosis intensive outpatient treatment services to our mental health program later this year. With a strong history and set of resources for the provision of transitional housing and supportive services, we will be opening our Seton House program in the summer to provide temporary housing and support services to young single mothers and their children experiencing homelessness. While they are participating in the program, we will help them find permanent housing and prepare them to positively change the trajectory of their lives.

This is an exciting time as we look carefully at the current and anticipated needs of the community and how Maryvale can best respond. While we continue to explore options for future paths we will take, we are dedicated to writing the next chapter for Maryvale and following the guidance of the Holy Spirit in continuing Maryvale's long and rich legacy of service in Los Angeles.

The need has never been stronger. Together with the Los Angeles Orphanage Guild, Maryvale has an incredible opportunity to change more lives for the better. It is with much appreciation that I thank you for being with us tonight and invite you to join us as we move forward in writing the next chapter of Maryvale's story.
