## 'Giving back is always the right answer'

The first question I usually get when I meet someone is "Where did you get your name?"

I was named after Indiana. Yes, the whole state. My Dad was known for being from Indiana. He was a television personality, host of several talk/game shows and a comedian. He was also a virtuoso harmonica player. That talent must have skipped a generation.

I was born in NYC and grew up in Larchmont, NY. I have twin brothers who some believe are older, some believe younger. I won't tell.

Living on the water in Larchmont, I was introduced to sailing, boating, diving and flying at a young age. These were my dad's passions. And they are mine, too. I spend time in Florida so I can be on the water or in it.

When I was in seventh grade we moved to L.A. because everyone on television

relocated to studios here. I grew up literally 10 minutes from where I live today. I went to Good Shepherd school, as did all six of the Carey children. So yes, I met Steve when I was 13. I was a grade ahead but the same age as Steve, so I assumed I was much smarter. That topic is still "under discussion."

I attended Marymount for three years but in my senior year my family retired to Ft. Lauderdale and I ended up at the University of Florida, graduating with a BA in Journalism. I worked in public relations straight out of college, writing for our clients and mostly for the Miami Herald. Many of the women who flew here to be with me tonight are my sorority sisters from UF days. We also travel together when we can. But after seven years in the Sunshine State, I decided I was just too tanned, so I moved back to LA.

I was fascinated with acting and got involved with the Beverly Hills Playhouse, as well as some guest spots on sitcoms, soap operas, a few bad movies, and a five-year stint with an Improv Troupe where I honed my skills as an incorrigible person. I actually discovered I like hosting shows better than being an actor on them, so I did as many as I could – *PM Magazine, The Rock Report, Pop Music,* and the *Home Show,* as well as the *Wil Shriner Show.* I did home tips and cooking segments on them and decided to actually teach cooking to some friends. I started a class with a chef, we paired wine and food long before it was popular and I thoroughly enjoyed taking my friends' money for something that was so much fun. Cookbook to follow.

Around that time we became part of the St. Paul the Apostle community. I enjoyed volunteering for everything including soccer mom, room mom, basketball mom, prom mom... all the while never owning or driving a minivan.

At St. Paul's I met Sue Ellen Waters, and we were paired as Head Room mothers. She was a great partner, and soon she was inviting me to join the Orphanage Guild, which I did in 1999. I loved the Guild from the start and the mission of helping abused, neglected and the forgotten children in the Los Angeles area. Being President of this group of talented women for two years was the best two years of my LAOG /LAMG life.

So, this is what brought me to tonight, standing here accepting a wonderful award for something I loved doing. This is unbelievable!

I am humbled to be among this group of women, who do so much every day for so many.

As we turn the corner on a new mission that Maryvale is called to embrace, I continue to be committed to the Guild and the children, and now with their mothers will restart their lives under the guidance and love of the Maryvale staff.



Dear Guild Members and Friends of Maryvale,

Welcome to the Los Angeles Maryvale Guild's 2023 "A Night in Paris" Gala, in support of Maryvale and the Los Angeles Maryvale Guild. We are so excited to spread the word of the important work of Maryvale and also, to be honoring our wonderful dear friend and Guild Member Indy Carey. Cheers Indy!

2022 was a year of changes for both Maryvale and the Los Angeles Orphanage Guild. The Guild has had a name change, we are now known as The Los Angeles Maryvale Guild. The Guild's name may have changed but our mission remains the same, supporting the important work of Maryvale.

What is Maryvale's new mission? As they pivot, from residential housing for children, Maryvale has shifted its work to addressing the ongoing issues of homelessness of young mothers and children. With the growth of homelessness in our communities, there is a crisis of over 60,000 families finding themselves unhoused. Maryvale has begun its work by revamping its campus and has opened the first of three family dorms to provide safe and secure short-term transitional housing to single mothers and their young children. Seton House provides a six-month program for these young families to get the tools and assistance they need to find permanent housing and, most importantly, to break the cycle of poverty. The families undergo a variety of programs, parental classes, job enrichment help, trauma therapy for both the young moms and their children. All in a safe, secure, and warm environment at Maryvale.

We have a motto at LAMG "Help a mother in need, and change a generation." Your support tonight will help us continue helping these young families find a path to growth and dignity.

# Seton House's temporary housing success leads to possible expansion of 20 residential units

Dear Friends of the Los Angeles Maryvale Guild,

Thank you for being here tonight to support the Guild's efforts on behalf of Maryvale. Through your generous support, Maryvale continues to grow and expand programs to assist families in need. Most recently, the opening of Seton House represents a new and exciting chapter in Maryvale's 167-year history.

Seton House provides temporary housing for unhoused or housing insecure mothers with up to two young children under the age of ten. While in the program, the mothers are provided case management support, mental health, and other supportive services to assist them in moving toward permanent housing and achieving their goals. At the same time, their preschool age children enroll in our early education center on the Rosemead campus.

Now, more than ever before, all of our program services – housing, mental health, and early education – integrate in support of the Seton House residents.

In the short time the program has been open, we have already seen positive outcomes. Two families have moved into permanent housing. Residents have completed educational goals such as Certified Nursing Assistant, Dental Assistant, Associate Degree, and one resident is soon to complete her high school diploma. We have also seen successes with some of the children. One three-year-old arrived to the program and was not yet potty trained. With support from the Seton House and early education staff, he is now doing fine. Another

Seton House's success – two families are moving into permanent housing, and residents are completing goals – a Certified Nursing Assistant, Dental Assistant, a high school diploma and completing an Associate of Arts Degree program. two-year-old moved into the program and was not speaking; she is now talking up a storm! The need is great! We have received over 100 referrals to the program since word spread we were preparing to open Seton House. Our plan now is to expand the program by reconfiguring an existing dorm on the Rosemead campus into twenty individual living units each with its own bathroom. We will then be able to house over 60 mothers with their children each year.

Today, Seton House is completely operating under private funding. The support of the Los Angeles Maryvale Guild, along with your generous support, is critical to helping fund and expand this program.

On behalf of the mothers and children living at Seton House, thank you for caring and doing your part to help Maryvale provide much needed assistance to them during this critical time in their journey. Together we are lifting up one individual, one family, one community at a time!




